THE SEASON OF LENT - "WILDERNESS TIME"

There is one path in and one path out, so the experience is calming and allows you to "collect" yourself. Prayer resources will be provided. Because we consider the labyrinth to be "holy ground," you will remove your shoes as you walk (please bring or wear socks). Enter by the front door of the Fellowship Hall.


